Dear Parents/Carers

Instrumental music lessons

I am writing to inform you of the opportunities available for year 7 students to learn musical instruments in school. Learning a musical instrument enables children to develop a wide range of skills that can help with their learning, such as organisation, concentration and self-discipline. It also gives children the opportunity to make new friends and have fun.

We subsidise all music tuition but have to make small charge for lessons. The cost is £24 per term and free for those children eligible for free school meals.

Specialist teachers from the Harrow Music Service provide lessons for our children, in order to give them the highest quality learning experience possible. Lessons are given in groups, normally of four children, and usually last for 25/30 minutes. You are welcome to apply for auditions for more than one instrument.

The lessons available are violin, drums, flute, keyboard, electric guitar and guitar.
